


Winter Reminders

- **DISCONNECT YOUR HOSES** from the tap to prevent freezing any burst/leaking hose bibbs will be charged back to the tenant as this is preventable damage (the water will freeze inside the hose back up into your wall and it will leak in spring).
- **DISPOSE OF TRASH PROPERLY** cardboard recycling flattened and put in bins, organic waste separated (NO PLASTIC BAGS) in green bins and only household waste in dumpsters. It is your responsibility to dispose of household furniture and other large items do not dump ANYTHING anywhere on site.
- **Pest Control and Prevention** Mice, rats, and other animals/pests are looking for warmth and food. Please don't leave any food or furniture outside your units that will help attract pests.

- Safety and Security This is a reminder to all tenants that all doors and gates should be closed and properly latched at all times. Tenants should not leave any valuables in their vehicles overnight; Keys, FOBs, personal belongings, etc., should be brought inside every night. ENFHS is not liable for any personal belongings that are damaged or stolen while on the premises. Tenants are responsible to obtain and maintain their own content insurance for their unit. This insurance will help recover costs of stolen or damaged property.
- NO SMOKING Please also be reminded that smoking and loud social gatherings may bother your neighbours. Please be courteous and keep in mind that many people get up early for school, work, kids, etc.

Holiday Break & Office Closure Notice



The offices of Entre Nous Femmes Housing Society will be closed for Holiday Break, **Monday December 25th** to Tuesday January 2nd.

If you have an emergency during this time, please call the emergency line at 604-945-2966. If it is not an emergency but rather a repair, please fill out a repair request form on our website at enfhs.ca/maintenance-requests.

Emergency is defined as the following:

- Fire.
- Flooding, major leaks in pipes or the roof.
- Damaged or blocked water or sewer pipes or fixtures.
- The heating system is not working.
- The electrical system is failing.
- Damaged or defective locks for rental units.

Please dispose of all garbage, recycling and compost properly, and do not leave any garbage anywhere on the property.

Please do not leave your garbage around the bins if they are full, the waste management company will not pick the bins up if they are obstructed by garbage bags. **Christmas trees will not be picked up by our garbage company.

Tenant Insurance



Tenants are reminded to obtain the appropriate insurance by the end of the year, to cover personal property and third person liability claims. <u>Tenant insurance should cover fire, flood, theft, and other potential dangers from items such as waterbeds and/or aquariums.</u>

Entre Nous Femmes Housing Society is a member of BC Non-Profit Housing Association (BCNPHA), which gives you the option of purchasing tenants insurance under this Tenants Insurance Program. Administered by Marsh Canada Limited, and underwritten by Intact Insurance Company, this program provides residents of non-profit housing societies that are BCNPHA members with the following insurance coverage:

- Personal Liability: \$1,000,000
- Contents: \$15,000 coverage limit; \$500 deductible
- Additional Living Expenses: \$6,000

Why Buy Tenants Insurance?

- Tenants **insurance covers loss or damage** to your contents caused by a number of insured events including; fire, smoke damage, water damage, vandalism and theft.
- Tenants liability **insurance can protect you if you are found liable for accidental injuries or damage** to another person or their property.
- Coverage for Additional Living Expenses are included up to the provided limit (e.g. hotel bills, restaurant meals, moving costs).
- Your contents may not be covered for damage caused by the building owner or other tenants.

Additional Coverage Features

- Higher limits are available on request.
- Earthquake coverage is available for an additional premium.
- Replacement cost on contents is included.
- Annual premium of \$150.
- No service fee for the convenient payment plan options offered.
- Access to Intact's 24-hour emergency claims service.
- Free access to Intact Assistance a suite of services including legal information and a family care assistance plan to provide support in times of need.

BCNPHA has partnered with <u>Marsh's Private Client Services</u>, to provide non-profit housing tenants with affordable tenant insurance. This affordable plan has an annual premium of \$150 as opposed to over \$300 for private residential tenants, and the ability for tenants to make monthly payments.

Recipes

Easy Apple Crisp

Ingredients

- Filling
 - o 1 medium apple
 - o 2 tsp brown sugar
- Crumble
 - o 2 tbsp quick-cooking oats
 - 1 tbsp brown sugar
 - 1 tbsp unbleached all-purpose flour
 - o 1 tbsp butter, softened

Preparation

- In a 1-cup (250 ml) mug, combine the apple and brown sugar.
- In a small bowl, combine the oats, brown sugar and flour. Add the butter and blend with your fingertips until the texture is crumbly. Sprinkle over the apple mixture. Cook in the microwave oven for 1 to 1 ½ minutes or until the juices are bubbling.
- Let cool for 5 minutes before serving.
