Program Overview

Objective

The Period Promise Program (the Program) aims to support menstrual equity and provide free access to essential health supplies by providing a three (3) year's supply of reusable menstrual products to Entre Nous Femmes Housing Society (ENFHS) residents who need them.

Disposable products may be available in each building throughout the year, upon receipt of donated products or additional funds for bulk purchases.

Who Can Participate

The Program is available to ENFHS residents who use menstrual products. Individuals of all ages and gender identities are welcome to participate. Residents must be 13 years of age or older to apply. For applications for children under 13, an adult must apply. **Participation per resident is limited to once every three years** for reusable products. Please note that funding is limited, and applications will be approved until available funds are exhausted.

Note: If you registered for re-usable products in 2023, you will be re-eligible in 2026.

How to Enroll

Residents can complete the application form attached and return it to periodpromise@enfhs.ca to enroll in the program or complete the application online at enfhs.ca/periodpromise. Please note that it can take up to five (5) business days to process your application form and confirm eligibility.

Product FAQ

Q: What size cup should I order?

Choose size A if you're new to cups or have trouble inserting tampons.

Choose size B if you've given birth or have a weak pelvic floor.

Distribution

ENFHS will maintain a supply of menstrual products (reusable menstrual underwear, menstrual cups, and liners) and partner with local suppliers or organizations for product donations or bulk purchases.

Once an application form is processed and eligibility is confirmed, ENFHS staff will contact the resident to complete the order based on their chosen product option. Residents will be notified when the products are ready.



Products will be distributed in a private and convenient method (e.g., confidential link, direct delivery, pick-up locations) depending on the option selected by residents on their application form.
